MATERIALS

FOX TROT QUILT FEATURING ED EMBERLEY'S PICTURE PIE

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard each: Foxes & Raccoon

$\frac{1}{3}$ yard each: Scribble {Black, Orange, Blue & Gray}

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard: White

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard Scribble {Gray} for binding

4 yards Alphabet for backing

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Cutting dimensions include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.

From each Foxes and Raccoon (cut lengthwise)

- 6- $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 2- $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 2- $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "

From each Scribble {Blue & Gray}

- 8- $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "

From Scribble {Orange}

- 12- $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "

From Scribble {Black}

- 16- $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "

White:

- 28- $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "

ASSEMBLY DIRECTIONS

1. Sew together one White piece and one Black Scribble ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "") rectangular piece on the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " inch side. Continue alternating white and black until 8 pieces are sewn together (4 white and 4 black total) [fig 1]. Make 3 more strips (4 total) and press to the dark fabric.

2. Repeat Step 1 using the Orange Scribble and White ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "") pieces (4 Orange and 4 White total for each strip) [fig 2]. Make 2 more strips (3 total) and press to the dark fabric.

ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

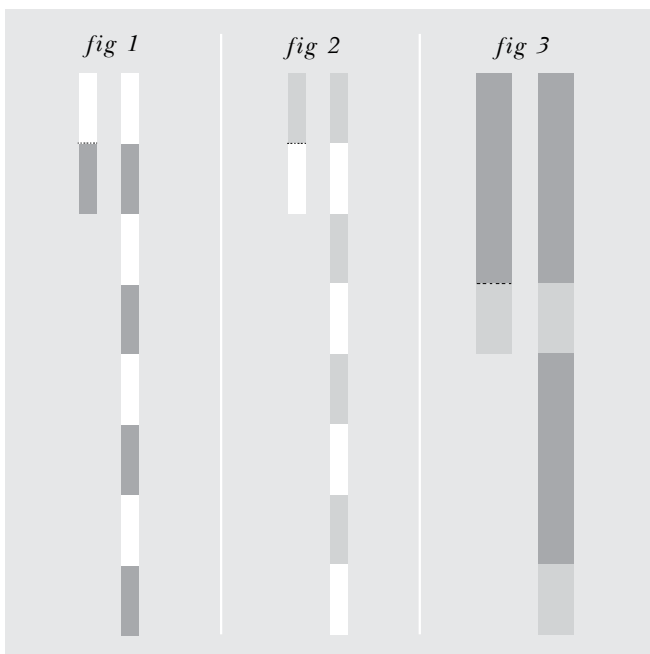
3. Arrange the remainder of the fabric pieces according to the quilt diagram *working in vertical*

rows. Row 1: sew a Fox ($4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ "") piece to a Gray Scribble ($4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "") piece. Then add another Fox ($4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ "") piece and end row with Gray Scribble ($4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ "") piece. Row 1 is complete. [fig 3] Follow **QUILT DIAGRAM** noting correct order and size of fabric. Press to the dark fabrics.

4. After all vertical rows are pieced, sew vertical Rows 1 and 2 together, rows 3 and 4 together. Continue sequence until quilt is pieced.

5. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste, quilt and bind.
